a. Principal's Report

Principal Chapman introduced Brandi Faison, TCA teacher and Robotics team sponsor, as well as the members of the TCA Robotics team. The Robotics team recently competed in the Tallahassee Regional competition, and each member of the team shared their name and what their role was in the competition, as well as their experience.

Principal Chapman gave an overview of STEM Immersion Week that took place from March 4th to March 8th and showcased employees of the STEM workforce, to expose students to a variety of work fields. TCA students also attended a presentation on the new degree pathways offered by TCC.

Principal Chapman introduced Jason McCandless, the COO of Career Source Florida, who shared his experience of their recent tour of TCA.

Data has reflected that TCA has exceeded their goal, by increasing the number of students dual enrolled from 11 students in Fall 2023 to 26 students in Spring 2024, with 59 students currently qualified to dual enroll.

SUBJECT: Enrollment Update

Item Description

This item provides an overview of the current enrollment numbers for the 2023-2024 school year, and updates on future enrollment numbers for 2024-2025.

Overview and Background

TCA has 147 students currently enrolled.

On March 1st, we sent acceptance letters to all of our incoming students and currently all 125 seats are filled for next year. We have 18 students on our waiting list.

We are also working on re-enrollment for next year; surveying our current families to find out who will be returning to TCA next year, and gathering necessary re-enrollment paperwork.

We currently have 266 students confirmed for enrollment for next year, with a goal of 275. Those not confirmed have verbally confirmed and are still working on gathering paperwork to formally complete the enrollment process.

Funding/ Financial Implications

The proposed budget for 2024-2025 is based on 275 students. This information item provides clarity that we have a solid number for next year.

SUBJECT: Academic Update

Item Description

This item provides an update regarding our academic goals and the extra support initiatives provided to students during final preparations for state standardized testing.

Overview and Background

During this time of year we are reviewing and preparing heavily for end of course exams and state standardized testing. Our primary academic goals remain focused on student achievement and growth. Recognizing that some students require additional assistance, we have implemented targeted support programs.

Several Saturdays are dedicated to providing additional support for students who demonstrate a need for personalized assistance. These sessions focus on addressing specific learning gaps tailored to the individual student and preparation for state testing.

We have extended tutoring sessions offered after school for our students on select dates in select subject areas. Students are invited to these by invitation, and parents have been informed for those that we strongly recommend tutoring.

SUBJECT: Safety & Security Update

Item Description

This item provides an update on Safety and Security processes and procedures, specifically related to Youth Mental Health First Aid.

Overview and Background

Effective November 22, 2022, Rule 6A-1.094120, Florida Administrative Code mandates that at least 80% of school personnel in a school district (including charter schools) must complete the FLDOE approved youth mental health awareness training. This Youth Mental Health First Aid (YMHFA) program helps school personnel identify and understand signs of mental health concerns and substance use disorders. School districts must submit an annual certification to the Department of Education by July 1 each year, confirming compliance with this requirement.

In order to offer the training locally, two individuals must be certified as a trainer. Assistant Principal Patricia Pagozalski possessed the certification upon hire. In January of this year, TCA sent school counselor Quashier Flood to the certification training in order to also become a certified trainer, allowing TCA to conduct training in-house.

Currently, 53% of TCA staff have been trained in Youth Mental Health First Aid. The remaining 47% will be trained on May 1, 2024 at TCA. After the May 1 training has been completed, an updated certification letter will be provided to TCC school district so that they will be able to submit to FLDOE that all TCA staff have complete the training, meeting the 80% threshold requirement.

Attached is the letter sent to TCC School District on April 8, 2024 with updates regarding the status of our staff training and the planned future training dates.

6A-1.094120 Youth Mental Health Awareness Training and Reporting.

- (1) Purpose. The purpose of this rule is to set forth requirements for training and reporting of Youth Mental Health Awareness Training, pursuant to Section 1012.584(5), F.S.
 - (2) Definitions. In this rule, the terms have the following meaning:
 - (a) "Department" means the Department of Education;
- (b) "School District" means the Florida Virtual School under Section 1002.37, F.S., the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind under Section 1002.36, F.S., Developmental Research (Laboratory) Schools under Section 1002.32, F.S., and districts set forth in Article IX, Section 4, of the Florida Constitution;
- (c) "School Personnel" means persons who must receive Youth Mental Health Awareness Training in any public school in a School District, including a charter school.
- (d) "Youth Mental Health Awareness Training" means programs designed to help school personnel identify and understand signs of emotional disturbance, mental illness and substance abuse disorders and provide school personnel with the skills to assist a person who may be developing or experiencing an emotional, mental health or substance use concern.
- (3) Approved Youth Mental Health Awareness Training. The program approved by the Department to provide Youth Mental Health Awareness Training to school personnel is listed at https://www.fldoe.org/schools/k-12-public-schools/sss/ymhat.stml. All school personnel identified as set forth in subsection (4) of this rule must receive this training.
 - (4) Presumptive Identification of School Personnel for Training and Certification.
- (a) The Department will provide, by February 1 of each year, a list of job codes or categories from the document entitled "Data Elements Staff" incorporated in Rule 6A-1.0014, F.A.C., Comprehensive Management Information System, in order to identify the positions that must receive Youth Mental Health Awareness Training. This list will be posted annually at https://www.fldoe.org/schools/k-12-public-schools/sss/ymhat.stml.
- (b) Unless a School District submits a request to establish another method of identifying school personnel and receives approval from the Department, a School District must use these job codes and categories and the persons who hold these positions as of February 1, when providing the certification required by this rule.
 - (5) Certification of Training.
- (a) The annual certification that at least 80% of school personnel in a School District, including school personnel at charter schools, have completed the approved youth mental health awareness training must be submitted to the Department on the form entitled "Annual Certification of Youth Mental Health Awareness Training," Form No. YMHAT-1 by July 1 of each year. This form, effective December 2022, is incorporated by reference (https://www.fldoe.org/schools/k-12-public-schools/sss/ymhat.stml.
- (b) This form must be submitted by the superintendent or designee. Instructions to submit this form may be obtained at https://www.fldoe.org/schools/k-12-public-schools/sss/ymhat.stml.
- (6) Charter Schools. School Districts must implement procedures to include school personnel at charter schools in the School District's certification. A School District may rely upon a charter school's certification without independent verification when submitting the School District's certification of training under subsection (5) of this rule.
